### VISIT TO RASHTRAPATI BHAVAN AND RASHTRAPATI BHAVAN MUSEUM

### ON 28 MARCH 2025

The Centre for Independence and Partition Studies (CIPS), University of Delhi, in collaboration with the Office of the Dean of Students' Welfare (DSW), organized a visit to Rashtrapati Bhavan and the Rashtrapati Bhavan Museum on Friday, March 28, 2025.
